Hononegah Community High School District 207 is located 12 miles north of Rockford in Rockton, Illinois. The district serves the communities of Rockton, Roscoe, Shirland and portions of South Beloit since 1923. The district encompasses approximately 109 square miles with a population of approximately 30,000.

School

HCHS is a comprehensive 4-year public high school with a current enrollment of 1950 students. HCHS is accredited by Cognia, formerly known as AdvancED, and is a member of the NIC-10 Conference. The school year consists of four, nine-week quarters and the school day is divided into seven periods. The first semester ends on December 17, 2021 and the second semester ends May 26, 2022.

Successful completion of US Government or AP US Government meets the state requirements for the Illinois and US Constitution tests.
